WHAT IS REAL ALE?

Real ale is a top fermented beer that, following fermentation, is put into a cask with yeast and some residual fermentable sugars from the malted barley. The beer undergoes a slow secondary fermentation in the cask to produce a gentle carbonation.



CAMRA LocAle is an initiative that promotes pubs stocking locally brewed real ale. The scheme builds on a growing consumer demand for quality local produce and an increased awareness of 'green' issues. It helps support local breweries and reduces 'beer miles' i.e. The number of miles and the corresponding fuel used before a pint arrives in your glass.

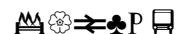

The pub features local breweriana including the original sign from Bradford's Trough brewery. The licensees are keen local historians and the landlord is the official town mace-bearer and steward. 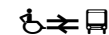

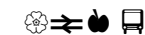

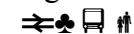
