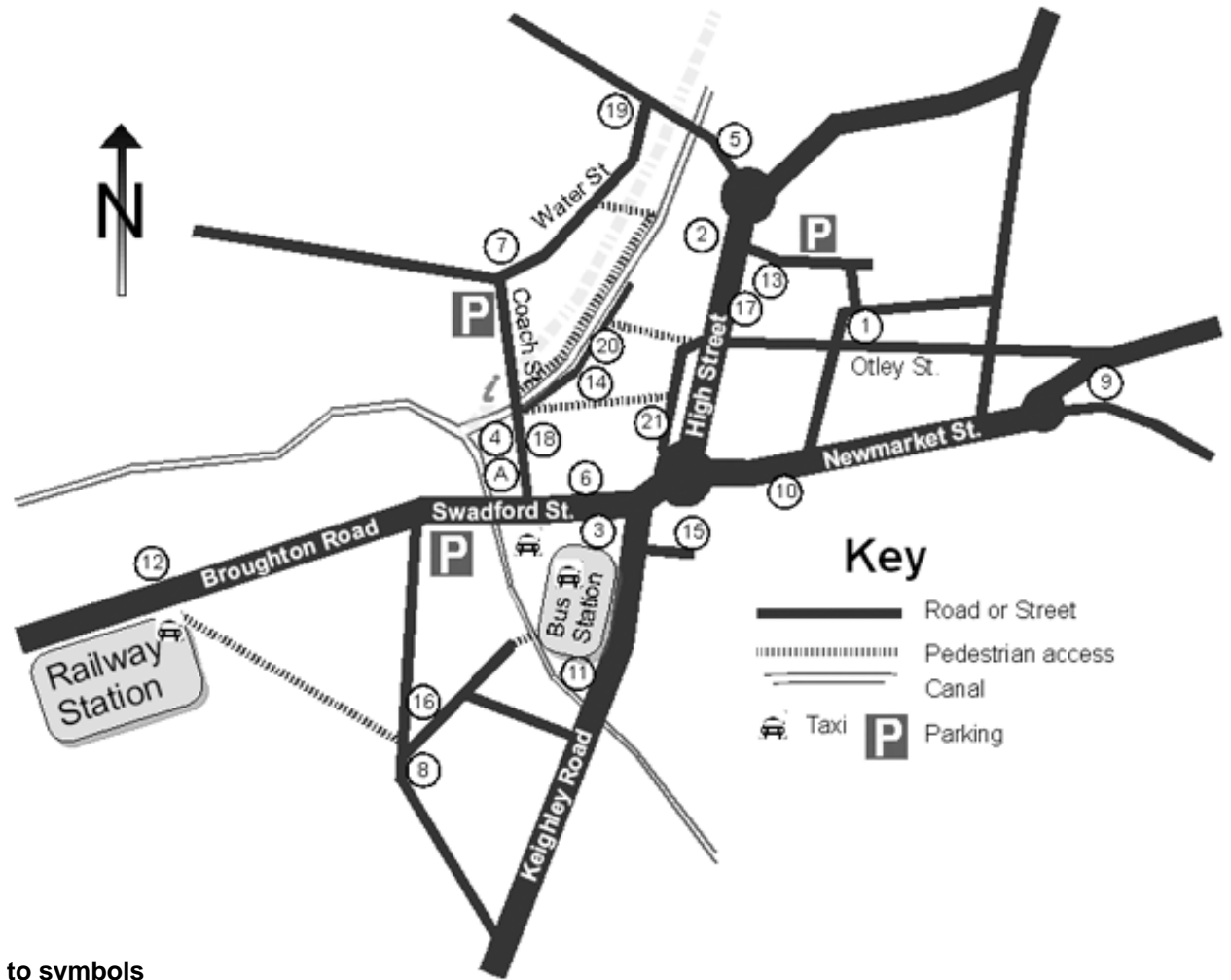

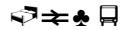

Very much a locals pub in a prominent position away from the town centre near the canal basin. Good value Bed & Breakfast accommodation.

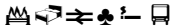


⑧ Craven Hotel

Just off the town centre a sympathetic refurbishment of an old pub by Wetherspoons. Pictures of the old pub adorning the walls.

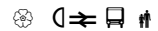


⑪ Fleece Inn
